Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ Hebrews 11:17
There are moments when faith feels stretched beyond what seems reasonable. God asked Abraham to place on the altar the very promise he had waited for. Sometimes the hardest tests are not about letting go of something bad, but trusting God with something good. Faith grows when we trust God not just with our struggles, but with our blessings. Open your hands in prayer today and symbolically give back to God something you've been holding tightly.

TUESDAY
READ Genesis 22:3
Abraham didn't delay. He didn't wait for clarity. He moved. That kind of obedience doesn't come from having all the answers; it comes from trusting the One who gives the command. Sometimes we stall because we want more information. But faith often begins with movement, not certainty. Stop delaying one step God has already made clear. Act on it today.

WEDNESDAY
READ Genesis 22:6-7
There was a long, silent walk up that mountain. Questions were asked. Answers were not fully given. Some seasons of faith feel like that (quiet, heavy, and uncertain). But even when the path feels unclear, God is still present in every step. Walk through your day with intentional awareness of God's presence, even if you don't have answers.

GOD IS NOT TESTING YOU TO BREAK YOU.
HE IS SHAPING YOU FOR WHAT'S NEXT.
AND WHEN YOU TRUST HIM FULLY,
FEAR LOSES ITS GRIP, AND HIS GLORY
TAKES ITS PLACE.

THURSDAY
READ Romans 4:20-21
Abraham's faith wasn't based on circumstances. It was rooted in who God is. When we remember God's character (His faithfulness, His power, His goodness) our confidence grows even when situations don't change. Faith is not wishful thinking. It is confidence in a trustworthy God. Write down one way God has been faithful to you in the past. Let it strengthen your trust today.

FRIDAY
READ Genesis 22:8
Abraham didn't know how God would provide, but he believed that He would. God always sees further than we do. What feels uncertain to us is already known to Him. Provision is often revealed at the point of obedience, not before it. Trust God with an unknown today. Replace "What if?" with "God will provide."

SATURDAY
READ Hebrews 11:19
Abraham's faith reached a place where he trusted God beyond logic. He believed God could do what had never been done before. That is the difference between being gripped by fear and living for God's glory. When faith takes that step, it opens the door for God to move in ways we never expected. Pray boldly today for something that feels impossible, trusting God's power more than your limitations.
