

Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ Luke 10:1

Ever look at someone amazing, like Michael Jordan, and think, "I want to be like that"? We all do! But the one we should truly want to be like is Jesus. Real leadership begins when I first say "Yes" to His call. He chose everyday people then, and He's choosing you and me now, to prepare the way for Him right where we are. Today, ask yourself: In what small way can I consciously follow Jesus' example – maybe in how I speak to someone or how I react to a challenge? Be His apprentice today.

TUESDAY
READ Luke 10:2

When Jesus sent His team out, He told them to Pray! "The harvest is plentiful," He said, "but the workers are few. So, ask the Lord..." How often do I jump into my busy day, my plans, before I've truly connected with Him in prayer? True obedience means recognizing it all depends on Him. Are we praying for God to send more people into His work, or are we trying to do it all ourselves? Before diving into your to-do list, pause. Spend a few minutes asking God to guide your day and to raise up others to serve Him. Let prayer be your starting line.

WEDNESDAY
READ Luke 10:3-4

Jesus said He was sending them "like lambs among wolves." That sounds a bit scary and vulnerable, doesn't it? It means leadership His way isn't about flexing my power, but leaning into His gentle strength. Then He said, "Carry no purse or bag..." For us, what "bags" am I carrying? Worry? The need to look good? My own agenda? He's asking me to trust Him enough to let go of those things that weigh me down from what truly matters. What's one "bag" – a fear, a desire for control, a distraction – you can consciously hand over to God today? Ask Him to help you travel lighter, focused on His path for you.

THURSDAY
READ Luke 10:5 & 9

Jesus told them to offer peace, heal the sick, AND "tell them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'" It's a combo! My actions of love and service open hearts, but then I need to gently point people to *why* – to Jesus and His amazing Kingdom. How am I tangibly showing God's love today? And am I ready to share the hope I have when the moment is right? Look for one chance today to actively serve someone. Then, pray for the courage to also share a word of hope or point them toward God's love, even in a simple way.

FRIDAY
READ Luke 10:17 & 20

The disciples came back buzzing – "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name!" They saw God do amazing things through them. But Jesus, so gently, refocused their excitement: "However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven." Wow. My biggest win isn't what I achieve *for* God, but the incredible truth that I *belong* to Him. My security is in Him, not my successes. Today, take a moment to just thank God that you are His. If something good happens, celebrate it, then let your deepest joy rest in the amazing fact that your name is written in heaven.

SATURDAY

So, what does leading like Jesus look like for me, today? It's about asking: Am I truly following Him first? Is prayer my lifeline, not a ritual? Am I saying "yes" to His Word, even when it's tough? Do people see His love in how I serve? And where is my deepest joy found? It's not about being perfect, but about letting Him shape me, then sharing that journey. Who is God nudging me to invest in, to lead closer to Him simply by how I'm trying to follow Him? Think of one person God might want you to encourage or walk alongside this week. How can your journey of following Jesus be an example that helps them find their way to Him or take their next step?
