**Sermon Challenges**

**MONDAY**  
**READ Haggai 1:12-13**  
The people heard God’s Word, responded with obedience, and began rebuilding. Before the work was finished, before the results were visible, God spoke a promise: “I am with you.” That matters. God did not wait until they had everything completed before He drew near. His presence met them in their obedience. Sometimes we want reassurance before we take the step. But often, we experience God’s nearness as we obey. Take one step of obedience today that you have been delaying, and trust that God is with you in it.

**TUESDAY**  
**READ Haggai 2:3**  
The rebuilt temple did not look impressive compared to Solomon’s temple. To some, it looked small and disappointing. But God was not measuring the work the way they were. We look at our prayers, parenting, serving, giving, or encouragement and wonder if it matters. But God sees faithfulness differently than we do. Small obedience in God’s hands is never wasted. Write down one small act of faithfulness you often overlook. Thank God that He sees it.

**WEDNESDAY**  
**READ Ezra 3:12**  
Some people shouted for joy while others wept in disappointment. The same foundation produced two very different responses. Why? Comparison. Comparison can make obedience feel insignificant. It convinces us that what God is doing now is less valuable because it looks different than what came before. But faithfulness is not measured by comparison. It is measured by obedience. Identify one area where comparison has discouraged you. Ask God to help you celebrate faithfulness instead of measuring yourself against others.

**TRUTH TO CARRY WITH YOU**  
DO NOT UNDERESTIMATE ORDINARY FAITHFULNESS. GOD SEES EVERY PRAYER, EVERY ACT OF SERVICE, EVERY MOMENT OF OBEDIENCE, AND EVERY EFFORT TO LEAD OTHERS TOWARD JESUS. THE GOD WHO SAID, “I AM WITH YOU,” STILL WALKS WITH HIS PEOPLE TODAY.

**HIS PRESENCE IS ENOUGH.**  
**REALIGN YOUR HEART.**  
**PUT GOD FIRST.**

**THURSDAY**  
**READ Haggai 2:4**  
God did not tell the people to quit because the work looked small. He told them to be strong and keep working. That is a word many of us need. Keep praying. Keep serving. Keep leading your family. Keep teaching your children. Keep showing up. Keep doing the quiet things that honor God. His presence matters more than visible progress. Choose one responsibility today that feels repetitive or unnoticed, and do it with renewed faithfulness.

**FRIDAY**  
**READ Zechariah 4:10**  
God rejoices over beginnings that people often overlook. A foundation. A seed. A prayer. A quiet act of obedience. A child learning to trust Jesus. A family choosing worship together. We may see small moments. God sees what they are becoming. The ordinary faithfulness of today may be shaping a legacy you cannot yet see. Speak encouragement today over someone who is faithfully doing something that may feel unnoticed.

**SATURDAY**  
**READ Haggai 2:9**  
The people could not see the whole story. They saw a smaller temple. God saw the day Jesus Himself would walk into it. That is the difference between our view and God’s view. We see today. God sees generations. We see the moment. God sees eternity. What feels small in your hands may be part of something far greater in His plan. Pray this today: “Lord, help me be faithful with what I can see while trusting You with what I cannot.”
