offering

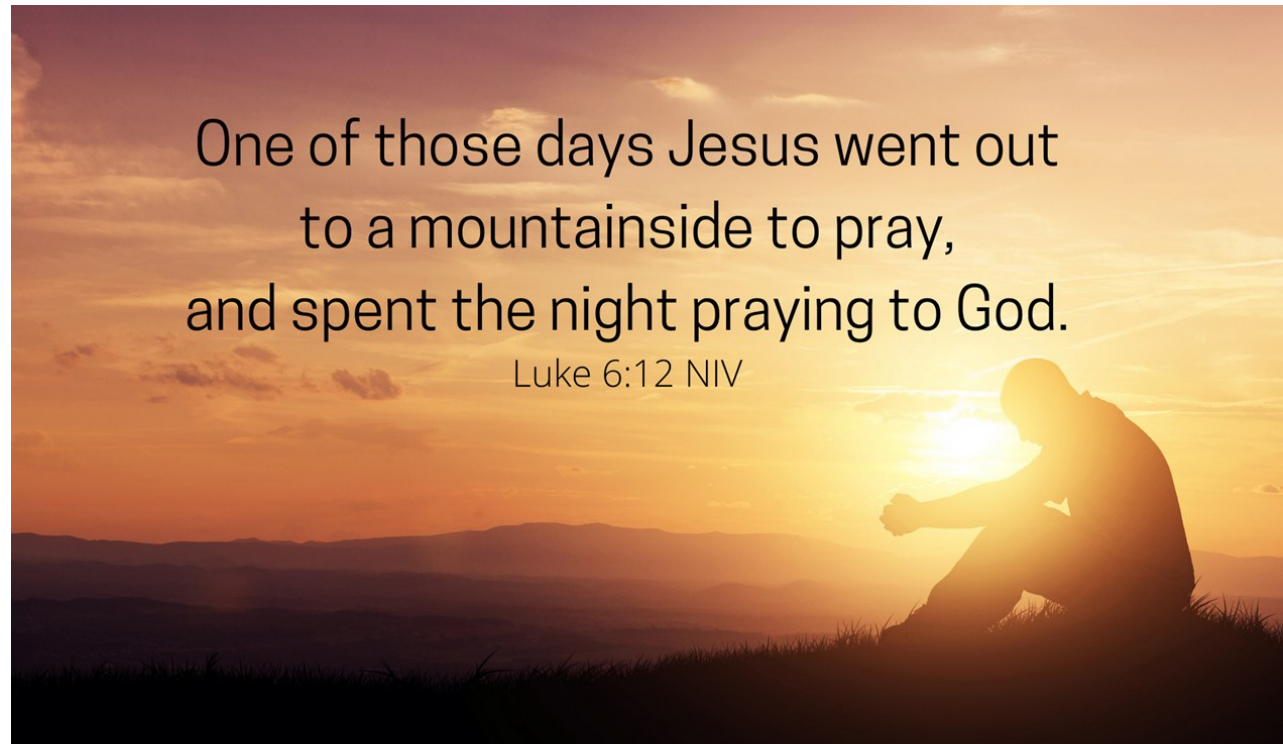

Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ Luke 10:40
Martha wasn't doing anything wrong. She was just doing too much. The problem wasn't her activity, it was her distraction. Chaos often comes not from bad things, but from too many things pulling at us at once. When everything feels urgent, it's easy to lose sight of what is most important. Pause today and ask: "What is actually most important right now?" Let that guide your focus.

TUESDAY
READ Luke 10:41-42
Jesus gently redirects Martha. He doesn't shame her, He refocuses her. Mary chose to sit at His feet, and Jesus said it would not be taken from her. In the middle of chaos, the best choice is not always doing more. It's staying close to Jesus. Set aside a few quiet minutes today to sit with Jesus: no distractions, just presence.

WEDNESDAY
READ Luke 6:12
Before choosing His disciples, Jesus stepped away from the noise and spent time with the Father. Even with demands and pressure around Him, He prioritized connection over activity. If Jesus needed time alone with God, we do too. Create intentional space today (even if it's brief) to pray without interruption.

THURSDAY
READ John 11:21
Martha's words carry disappointment. She believed in Jesus, but she struggled with what didn't happen. Faith doesn't eliminate questions. Sometimes it brings them into the open. Jesus does not turn away from honest disappointment. He meets us in it. Be honest with God today about an area where you feel disappointed. Bring it to Him instead of holding it in.

FRIDAY
READ John 11:23
Jesus speaks hope into a situation that felt final. Martha saw the limitation. Jesus saw what was coming. When chaos clouds our vision, we tend to focus on what we can see. But God is always working beyond what is visible. His perspective is greater than our present moment. When worry rises today, remind yourself: "God sees more than I do."

SATURDAY
READ Luke 10:39
In a world full of noise, Mary chose presence. She stayed close. That's the invitation for us too. God is not asking you to manage everything. He is asking you to remain with Him. Closeness to Jesus brings clarity in chaos. End your day by sitting quietly with God for a few minutes, simply acknowledging His presence.
