Sermon Challenges

MONDAY

READ 1 Samuel 16:7

We often overlook the small, judging by appearances. Samuel sought a king among prominent sons, but God saw potential in David, the young shepherd—a small role. Similarly, small Bethlehem (Micah 5:2) birthed the Messiah. God uses the unexpected for his BIG plans. Your small beginnings can hold significant divine purpose. Identify one “small” area of your life or task today. Pray for God to reveal its potential and how He might use if for a BIGger purpose.

TUESDAY

READ 1 Samuel 16:11

David, the smallest and overlooked, was CHOSEN by God. You are also CHOSEN. Feeling small or unqualified doesn’t negate God’s call; He equips the CALLED. Your perceived smallness can magnify God’s BIG strength through you. Reflect on a time your felt CHOSEN or CALLED, even if daunted. Thank God for seeing your potential and reaffirm your willingness to be used, no matter how small you feel.

WEDNESDAY

READ John 6:9

A boy’s small lunch seemed inadequate for a multitude, yet Jesus transformed it into a BIG miracle. What small thing do you possess—talent, resources, time? Don’t underestimate its potential when offered to God. Your “little” can have immense, SIGNIFICANT impact in His hands. Offer something “small” to God today—a prayer, a kind word, a simple service. Trust He can multiply its SIGNIFICANT impact.

THURSDAY

David was anointed king (1 Samuel 16) long before he reigned, enduring years of PATIENCE and small moments. Becoming who God intends is often gradual, built on small, faithful steps. These moments of waiting and trusting shape our potential for the BIG calling. Value these times of PATIENCE. Feeling impatient? Practice PATIENCE today by focusing on the next small, faithful step, trusting God with the BIG picture.

FRIDAY

Life is woven from countless small moments. We often miss God’s SIGNIFICANT work in the everyday while looking for BIG events. David learned leadership in small shepherding tasks, preparing him for kingship. Every small choice and act of obedience is a SIGNIFICANT part of your “becoming”. Pay attention to today’s small moments. Look for God’s presence and purpose. Journal one small moment where you recognized God’s hand or felt a nudge towards your CALLED purpose.

SATURDAY

“Becoming” is allowing God to work through our perceived smallness for His BIG will. From small Bethlehem (Micah 5:2) to a boy’s small offering (John 6:9) to shepherd David (1 Samuel 16), God uses the overlooked. Embrace your “smallness” as fertile ground for His SIGNIFICANT work. You are CHOSEN, CALLED, with divine POTENTIAL. Embrace one aspect where you feel “small”. Offer it to God, asking Him to use it for His glory, trusting He is shaping you into who He CALLED you to be.
