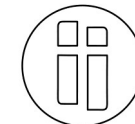

Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ Matthew 6:1-4
We have had a terrible habit from the time Adam and Eve were tossed from the Garden of Eden all the way to today. Too many seek the approval and honor from other people. As this week begins, pray that your focus will be on seeking the approval of God and God alone.

TUESDAY
READ Matthew 6:5-15
Jesus spends a little time on giving to the needy, but His discourse on prayer is much larger. Prayer is our connection with the Almighty and Jesus not only wants to make sure we know how to pray but what our motivations are when we pray. So often we go through the motions of prayer without actually connecting with God. Take a moment to read through the model prayer that Jesus gives us. Consider each phrase and pray through them one by one. Give God the praise, ask for forgiveness, and ask Him to help you open your heart and life to Him. Don't miss out on allowing God to speak to and through you.

WEDNESDAY
READ Matthew 6:16-18
We have seen that we are expected to give to the needy, pray, and now to fast. To fast is to give up on the daily necessities to focus that time on God. All three of these things are important, but Jesus reminds us that there is more to following Him than just the actions. The Pharisees had all the actions and motions, but they had nothing on the inside. Jesus encourages us to focus on our hearts and the actions will come. Are you going through the motions in your faith? Take a moment and ask God to help you to grow in your faith so that what you do comes from your heart.

THURSDAY
READ Matthew 6:1-18
Why is Jesus bringing this up? Because our motivations are important to him! The question we should ask ourselves when we're serving is, "Who am I serving?" If the answer is anything but Jesus, then our motives are wrong—and that's exactly what Christ is addressing in this chapter. Who are you serving? Is it your focus on this world or your relationship with Jesus? Take some time today to commit your life to always put your focus on Jesus.

FRIDAY
READ Matthew 6:21
Matthew 6:33
Our treasure, the thing we long for the most, cannot be in this world if we expect to ever enter God's Kingdom. If our treasure is here then our reward is here too. To love this world is to put us in the position of being an enemy of God. When we consider the world compared to Christ and His kingdom, there is no comparison. Seek first the kingdom of God and He will bring to you the reward and the blessings you need. Today is the day to spend some time in prayer asking the Lord to keep you focused, to fix your eyes on Jesus.

SATURDAY
READ Matthew 7:21-23
Our righteous actions, unless paired with a pure heart, will not get you into God's kingdom. Give your whole life to our Lord and Savior. Now is the time to focus on Him. Spend some time reading from His Word and Pray for yourself and those you love. He is here for you. Then Raise the Body (encourage someone on their journey) and Reach the Broken (invite someone to come to worship with you tomorrow). Don't let anyone miss out.
