# Sermon Challenges

#### THURSDAY **READ Psalm 51:10-12**

The Jews had never matured in their understanding of what God wanted from them. They thought external compliance with the works of the law were sufficient to please God. Don't we think the same sometimes? They claimed that people could be righteous because of their actions. Their actions could have been right while their hearts were corrupt. God wants both the heart and the actions. Look inward today and repent. Ask for a pure heart.

#### TUESDAY **READ Matthew 5:1-2**

MONDAY

There are two parts of Jesus' life that

all remember: Christmas and Easter.

On Christmas He came into our dark

world to bring His light. On Easter He

paid the price for our sins and gave us the opportunity to be with God in

heaven. The part so often forgotten is

the part in between. Jesus grew up.

Jesus showed us how to live for God. It

is that in between part that we focus on

now. Begin this week by asking God to

help you learn from what happened in

between.

The Sermon on the Mount is the keystone and foundation for so many of Jesus' teachings. It contains the Beatitudes, the model praver, and the Golden Rule. Even secular people can't ignore its teachings. Jesus is literally changing the world. Christ wanted to be sure everyone clearly understood his expectations of what kingdom living looked like. Do you understand what it means to live for Jesus in this world? Take this moment to ask for God's help in digging deeper. Ask Him to help you see and learn from Jesus and His example to know how to live for God.

#### WEDNESDAY **READ Matthew 5**

Think of a child being told from the time they were very young not to touch the stove. It makes perfect sense to the adult who is giving the warning. But the child needs to learn themselves. God does not want us to obey because we are told, but because we understand. God wants us to mature in our faith. That was what Jesus was saying. Pray that your faith would grow so that you too might understand and follow.

#### FRIDAY **READ Matthew 5:20**

The Pharisees were seen as the pillar of righteousness. They lived their outward lives fully committed to the Law. They even went above and beyond. They took the Law and added to it so that they would never break the Law itself. No wonder they were once knows as the "Pious Ones." But Jesus said that our righteousness should be greater than theirs. He meant that it had to be both outward and inward. Heart and life working together for Jesus. Jesus still calls for that in us. Thank Him today because He cares about you. He wants all of you.

#### SATURDAY READ Hebrews 12:1-2 Philippians 4:13

Let your outward behavior be a byproduct of what is in your heart. This message of Jesus changes everything. Now is the time to focus on Jesus. Spend some time reading from His Word and Pray for yourself and those you love. He is here for you. Then Raise the Body (encourage someone on their journey) and Reach the Broken (invite someone to come to worship with you tomorrow). Don't let anyone miss out.
