offering

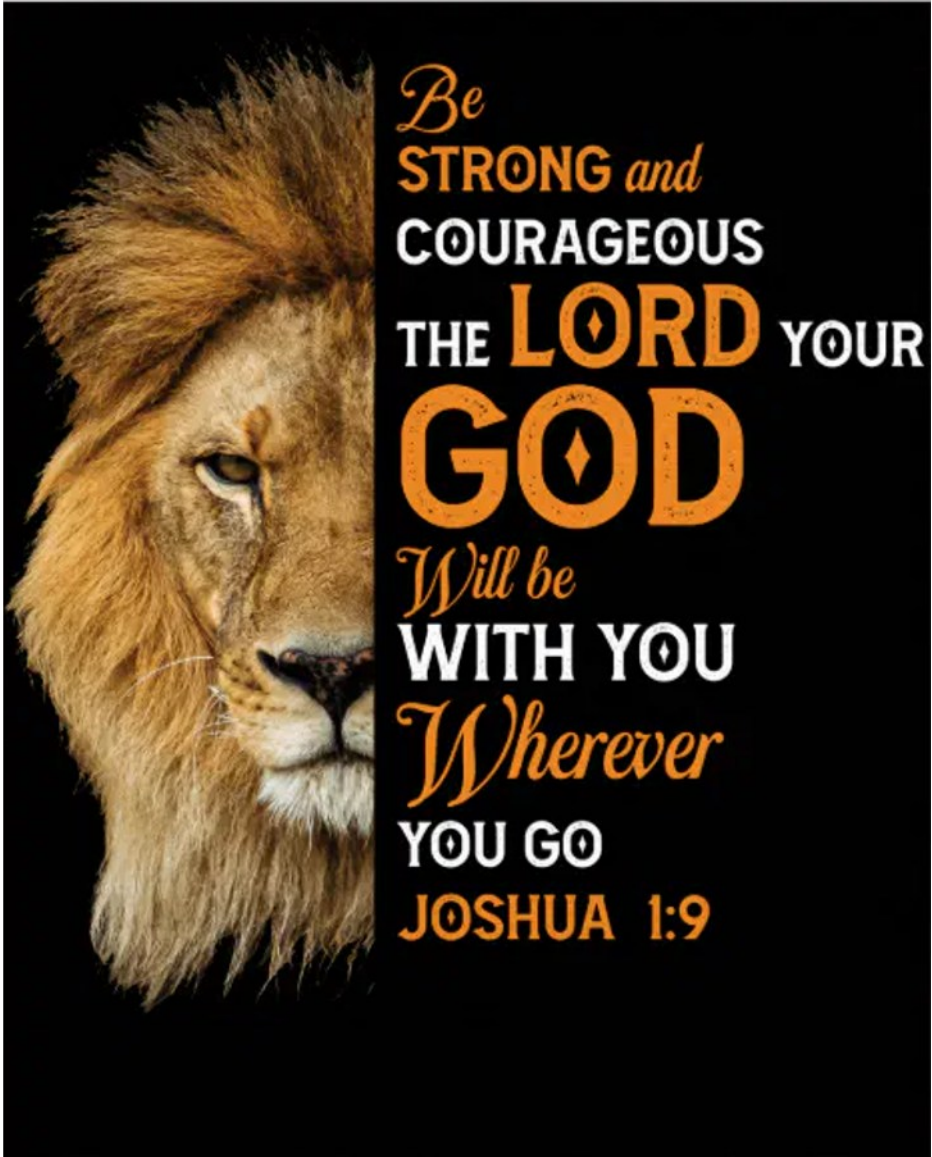

Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ Joshua 1:1-2
Moses was gone. Joshua was stepping into a role that probably felt bigger than him. The people needed leadership. The promised land was ahead. The pressure was real. Fear often gets loud at the edge of something new. It tells us we are not ready, not strong enough, not capable enough. But God did not begin by telling Joshua what he lacked. He reminded him that it was time to move forward. Fear may speak loudly, but it does not get the final word. Write down one fear that has been speaking loudly in your life. Then pray, “God, help me hear Your voice louder than this fear.”

TUESDAY
READ Joshua 1:5
Joshua’s courage was based on God’s presence. God didn’t say, “Joshua, you can handle this alone.” He said, “I will be with you.” That changes everything. The question is not whether you feel strong enough. The question is whether you believe God is faithful enough. You are not walking into life alone. God is with you, working through you, and fighting for you. Repeat this truth throughout the day: “God is with me.” Let that shape how you face what is in front of you.

WEDNESDAY
READ Joshua 1:6
God tells Joshua to be strong and courageous before the battles begin. Courage is not the absence of fear. It is choosing obedience even when fear is present. Sometimes we wait to feel brave before we act. But courage often comes as we take the step, not before. God’s voice calls us forward when fear tells us to stay still. One faithful step can change the conversation in your heart. Take one small step today that fear has been trying to talk you out of.

TRUTH TO CARRY WITH YOU
FEAR AND DISCOURAGEMENT DO NOT HAVE TO CONTROL THE CONVERSATION.
GOD IS NOT AGAINST YOU.
HE IS WITH YOU.
HE IS WORKING THROUGH YOU.
HE IS FIGHTING FOR YOU.
SO, CHOOSE THE VOICE OF GOD OVER THE VOICES OF FEAR.

THURSDAY
READ Joshua 1:8
What you listen to will eventually shape how you live. God told Joshua to keep His Word close because the battles ahead would require more than confidence. They would require truth. The world sends messages constantly: prove yourself, protect yourself, promote yourself. But God’s Word speaks something better. It reminds us who God is, who we are, and what matters most. The strongest voice in your life should be the voice of God. Choose one verse from Joshua 1 and carry it with you today. Read it more than once and let it guide your thoughts.

FRIDAY
READ Joshua 1:9
Discouragement can become a voice in our headset. It says, “Nothing will change.” “You are failing.” “This is too much.” “You should quit.” But God speaks directly to that voice. Do not be afraid. Do not be discouraged. Why? Because He is with you wherever you go. Discouragement does not have to define your future. God’s presence gives you strength for today and hope for tomorrow. When discouragement shows up today, answer it with Joshua 1:9: “The Lord my God is with me wherever I go.”

SATURDAY
READ Joshua 1:10-11
After God spoke courage into Joshua, Joshua gave the people a step to take. Get ready. Prepare. Move forward. Faith is not passive. It listens to God and then acts. Victory would not come by Joshua staying where he was. It would come as he trusted God one step at a time. God may not show you the whole path today, but He will give you the next step. Listen to His voice. Trust His promise. Move forward in faith. Ask God, “What is my next faithful step?” Then do it today.
