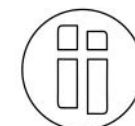

Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ Matthew 6:21
Jesus does not say our treasure follows our heart. He says our heart follows our treasure. What we keep investing in eventually begins shaping us. Our time, energy, resources, attention, and dreams all pull our hearts in a direction. That means the question is not only, “What do I value?” The deeper question is, “What is forming my heart?” Look at where your time, money, and attention have gone this week. Ask God what those things reveal about your heart.

TUESDAY
READ Matthew 6:19-20
Jesus reminds us that earthly treasures can be destroyed, stolen, lost, or left behind. Possessions are not sinful, but they are not strong enough to carry the weight of our security. Everything we accumulate here eventually passes through our hands. The danger begins when temporary things become ultimate things. Choose one possession, goal, or comfort you’ve been holding tightly and pray, “Lord, help me keep this in its proper place.”

WEDNESDAY
READ Luke 12:16-21
The rich farmer looked successful from the outside. His fields produced more than expected, and his future seemed secure. But his plans were filled with “my crops,” “my barns,” “my grain,” and “my future.” There was plenty of room for grain in his barns, but no room for God in his plans. The issue was not that he had wealth. The issue was that wealth had become the center of his life. Before making plans today, ask, “God, where do You fit into this?” Invite Him into your decisions.

THURSDAY
READ Luke 12:21
“This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God.” That phrase should stop us: rich toward God. It means a life invested in what matters to Him. People. Generosity. Faithfulness. The gospel. The Kingdom. A full schedule and a full bank account cannot satisfy an empty soul. Jesus is inviting us to live for something that lasts. Find one way today to be rich toward God through generosity, encouragement, service, or prayer.

FRIDAY
READ Deuteronomy 6:6-7
God’s truth is meant to be passed on in ordinary moments: at home, on the road, when we lie down, and when we get up. Spiritual investment in the next generation does not happen accidentally. It requires intentional time, prayer, love, and example. Buildings fade. Careers end. Possessions move on. But people matter forever. Encourage or pray for a child, student, parent, teacher, coach, or school worker today.

SATURDAY
READ Matthew 6:24
“No one can serve two masters.” Jesus does not simply ask what we own. He asks what owns us. Money, success, control, status, comfort, relationships, and even our own plans can become treasure when they take the place that belongs to God. The gospel gives us the reason we can surrender: before Jesus ever asks us to trust Him with what we treasure, He shows us how deeply we are treasured by Him. He gave Himself for us. Pray this today: “Jesus, show me what owns my heart, and help me surrender it fully to You.”
