Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ Matthew 6:25
Jesus speaks into an anxious world with simple but powerful words: “Do not worry.” He is not pretending life is easy. Bills pile up. Health concerns come. Relationships strain. The future can feel uncertain. But Jesus reminds us that fear does not have to lead us. Worry becomes dangerous when it starts acting like our master. It tells us what to think, how to feel, and what to expect. But when Jesus is Lord, fear no longer gets the final word. Name one worry that has been leading your thoughts. Pray, “Jesus, You are Lord over this too.”

TUESDAY
READ Matthew 6:26
Jesus tells us to look at the birds. They do what they were created to do without being consumed by tomorrow. The Father feeds them, and Jesus asks, “Are you not much more valuable than they?” Worry shrinks our world until one concern feels like the whole story. But Jesus lifts our eyes. Your problem may be real, but it is not ultimate. God is still present, still caring, and still faithful. Step outside or look out a window today. Let something in creation remind you that your Father has not forgotten you.

WEDNESDAY
READ Matthew 6:27
Jesus asks whether worry can add even a single hour to our lives. It cannot. Worry promises control but gives us none. Concern sees a problem and asks, “What faithful step can I take?” Worry circles the problem and says, “Everything depends on me.” God is not calling you to be irresponsible. He is calling you to trust Him. There are faithful steps you can take, and there are outcomes only God can carry. Write down one worry. Beside it, write one faithful step you can take. Then release what only God can control.

THURSDAY
READ Matthew 6:31-32
Jesus does not simply say, “God knows.” He says, “Your heavenly Father knows.” That changes everything. A powerful God knows the future. A loving Father cares about you within it. God sees the pressure you carry. He sees the fear that returns late at night. He sees the future you cannot figure out. His care is not distant or theoretical. It is personal. Pray honestly about what you need today. Speak to God not only as powerful, but as Father.

FRIDAY
READ Matthew 6:33
Jesus does not only tell us what to stop doing. He tells us what to do instead: “Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness.” Worry is weakened when our focus shifts from the size of the problem to the goodness and authority of God. Instead of only asking, “How will I get through this?” begin asking, “How can I honor God in this?” His promises must become louder than your fears. Before you focus on today’s problems, spend time focusing on God’s kingdom. Ask, “What would faithfulness look like today?”

SATURDAY
READ Matthew 6:34
Jesus calls us back to today. Many of us are carrying today’s burdens plus everything that might happen tomorrow. But God often gives grace like manna: strength for today, wisdom for today, mercy for today. Tomorrow’s grace will be there when tomorrow arrives. The world says peace comes when everything is settled. Jesus offers peace through His presence in the trouble. Christian peace is not based on a perfect forecast. It is based on a faithful Savior. Pray this today: “Jesus, I trust You with today. I trust You with tomorrow. Help me follow You without fear.”
