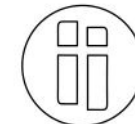

Sermon Challenges

MONDAY
READ John 10:27
We live surrounded by voices. Some voices tell us who to be, what to fear, what to chase, and what will finally make us happy. But not every voice knows where it is leading us. Jesus says, “*My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.*” The question is not whether voices will speak. They will. The question is which voice gets the final word. Following Jesus begins with learning to recognize His voice above the noise. Turn down one source of noise today and spend a few minutes listening to Jesus through Scripture and prayer.

TUESDAY
READ John 10:3
The shepherd calls his sheep by name. That means Jesus does not lead a faceless crowd. He knows His people personally. He knows where you are, what is wearing you down, what fears you have not spoken, and where you feel confused. You are not anonymous to Him. There is deep comfort in knowing that the One who leads you also knows you completely. Pray honestly today about one thing you have kept hidden from others. Remember that Jesus already knows and still calls you His own.

WEDNESDAY
READ Psalm 23:2-4
A good shepherd does not point from a distance. He leads from the front. Psalm 23 reminds us that the Shepherd leads beside quiet waters, restores the soul, and guides along right paths. But it also speaks of valleys. Following Jesus does not mean every road will be easy. It means we never walk alone. We often want the whole map. Jesus gives us something better: Himself. Ask Jesus today for enough trust to take the next step, even if you cannot see the whole road.

THURSDAY
READ John 10:4-5
Jesus says His sheep do not follow a stranger because they do not recognize the stranger’s voice. That matters because many voices compete for our attention. Fear, shame, culture, desire, and comparison all try to lead us. If we listen long enough, those voices begin shaping how we think and live. Feelings matter, but they are not the final authority. The Shepherd’s voice will always agree with His Word. When a strong feeling or desire rises today, ask, “Does this agree with what Jesus has already said?”

FRIDAY
READ John 10:11
“I am the good shepherd.
The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.”
Jesus is not just another voice offering advice. He is the Shepherd who gave Himself for us. A hired hand runs when danger comes, but the Shepherd stays. He does not use the sheep. He does not abandon them. He saves them at the expense of Himself. The cross proves that His voice can be trusted. Thank Jesus today for staying, loving, and laying down His life for you.

SATURDAY
READ Isaiah 53:6
“We all, like sheep, have gone astray.”
Sheep wander, and so do we. Sometimes we follow our own desires, listen to the wrong voice, and drift farther than we intended. But the Good Shepherd does not stop loving wandering sheep. He came looking for us, gave His life for our sin, and rose from the grave so we could come home. The Shepherd still calls today. The question is whether we will listen and follow. Pray this today: “Jesus, help me hear Your voice, trust Your heart, and follow where You lead.”
